

In 2012, the Minnesota Chief Engineers Guild scholarship program awarded \$8000, to fifteen students currently enrolled in post-secondary education. Applications for the 2013 scholarships are now being accepted, through July 31. The scholarship application can be found on our website. The application process includes a personal statement, including GPA, as well as a summary of school and work experiences, community involvement, and career goals. Applications are reviewed by the scholarship committee, with awards being given in early fall.

Funds for the scholarship program are raised through our annual golf classic, and an event held at the annual conference. Donations from individuals and organizations are greatly appreciated, and are accepted throughout the year. All contributors are recognized at our annual conference, and in our newsletter.
