
# Minnesota Chief Engineers Guild Update

# JUNE QUARTERLY MEETING FEATURED ST. CROIX CROSSING PROJECT

The MNCEG June Quarterly Meeting on June 4, 2018 provided an interesting inside look at the St. Croix Crossing project – the bridge connecting Oak Park Heights, Minnesota and St. Joseph, Wisconsin. This project is the largest public works bridge project in Minnesota history, and is the longest extradosed bridge in the country (a hybrid of a cable-stayed and segmental box bridge structure).



Total cost of the project was \$624 to \$646 million and took four years and three months to build. HDR was honored for their work on this project with three awards by the American Council of Engineering Companies of Minnesota and advanced to the national competition held in April. It was named the People's Choice Award winner in addition to receiving both a Grand Award and the Grand Conceptor Award, the state's top honor.

Thank you to Paul Kvisto from MnDOT and Craig Lenning from HDR for sharing their knowledge and experience with this monumental project.

Also thank you to Howard Berny from the Department of Labor & Industry, Boiler Division, for providing an update on Boiler Codes in Minnesota. Which leads to our next article....
