This is a cutting edge facility just brought back on line in November 2017 after being decommissioned in 2000. The 104-year-old heating plant on the University of Minnesota's Twin Cities campus has been resurrected as a cutting-edge "co-generation" combined heat and power utility that is 83 percent energy-efficient – more than double the efficiency of a coal-fired power plant.


