

In 2013, just under \$10,000 was awarded in scholarships as part of the Minnesota Chief Engineers Guild Scholarship Program. This program provides scholarships for individuals enrolled in post-secondary educational institutions. Scholarships applications are being accepted from now through July 31, and awards are made each fall, with the official announcement made at the MnCEG Fall Conference. The Scholarship Program is funded through events and contributions.
